## MEET ORLANDO AND LUCY ROMERO

From a young age, Brother Orlando Romero sensed a calling to something greater. At 21, shortly after his conversion, he felt a deep burden — not only to know God but also to share His love and the message of the cross with others.

That calling developed over years of faithful service. Brother Orlando served in his local church, preached wherever possible, and pastored for over a decade in three congregations in Morelos, Mexico. In 2017, through the “*Cristo Viene*” ministry, he accepted the call to go beyond borders and enter the mission field.

Since then, he and his wife, Lucy, have served for eight years across South America, including Peru, Bolivia, Chile, Argentina, and now Paraguay. They preach the gospel and disciple new believers in growing communities of faith.

## “CRISTO VIENE” SIGNIFICANCE

For Brother Orlando, “*Cristo Viene*” is a reality: Christ is coming soon. Reflecting on Revelation (Rev. 1:8; 22:12), he believes the message is clear: The gospel must be preached now.

## Lives Changed Along the Way

Through his ministry, Brother Orlando has seen God’s power transform lives. Zulema, a young girl once limited by illness and poverty, now walks, smiles, and communicates. And her family has come to faith.

## FAITH IN THE MIDST OF CHALLENGE

Missionary life brings challenges: cultural barriers, isolation, and logistical difficulties, often far from established congregations. Yet through it all, Brother Orlando and his wife remain grounded. “The mission belongs to God,” he shares. “We depend on Him for everything.” Through prayer, Scripture, and virtual fellowship, they stay spiritually strong. They are reminded that the mission is sustained by God’s grace, not human effort.

His work reflects a greater vision: to expand the gospel across nations and invite the Church to participate through prayer, giving, and going.
