



CHURCH MODELS THE HEART OF GC MISSIONS

There are moments in ministry when the overflow itself becomes the testimony. And that's exactly what happened recently in Albuquerque, New Mexico. The Church of God (Seventh Day) gathered for a local mission outreach with one simple goal: Invite someone who needs to experience God's love.

The event took place at a neighborhood gym, where members served meals, shared encouragement, and built connections with co-workers and neighbors. "I thought 150 plates would be more than enough," the organizer shared with a smile. "But people kept coming — until we literally ran out of plates! We started serving meals on aluminum foil. That's when I knew God had answered our prayers."

KEY MESSAGE

Between the laughter, music, and aroma of good food, a short but powerful message was shared: "We are the average of the five people we spend the most time with. So why not spend time with people who will build you up, encourage you, and draw you closer to God?"
